The award will recognize the most outstanding <u>service</u> activity or event that a group has participated in this year (from April 1, 2021 to the present) that has benefited the greater Plattsburgh community. Since 1960, the Presidents' Cup has been most prestigious award that can be bestowed upon a student group. This award represents excellence above all others and has long been sought after by student groups. As tradition, the recipient will have their name added to the Presidents' Cup plaque, to be included among a long list of past recipients. The cup is displayed for all to see in the Student Association Office.

All recognized State University of New York College at Plattsburgh organizations, clubs and teams are eligible to apply for the Presidents' Cup. Any group wishing to compete for this prestigious award must complete the attached application form and submit it to the Center for Student Involvement, ACC Room 106, by 4:00 pm on Friday, April 8, 2022.

The Presidents' Cup Award Committee will judge the applicant's answers and supporting material surrounding four core areas.

- 1. How the organization meets its mission statement.
- 2. How it promotes scholarship within its membership.
- 3. How it contributes to the State University of New York College at Plattsburgh.
- 4. How it serves the greater community and/or region we reside in.

The determination of the winner will be based on the information supplied on the application and supporting material only. No information will be entertained that is not supplied directly from the application so that all applicants have an equal opportunity to compete.

Once a winner has been chosen it cannot be disputed. The President of the Student Association along with the College President will then present the award to the winner before the close of the Spring 2022 Semester.

The Presidents' Cup Selection Committee will be selecting not only winners for the Presidents' Cup, but will also recognize organizations who achieve 2nd and 3rd place respectively. The organization which wins the Presidents' Cup, in addition to having their group's name on the Cup, will also be granted \$500 for the Fall 2022 semester to be distributed to their budget,

allocated to them by the Student Association. The 2nd and 3rd place organizations will be granted \$300 and \$200, respectively, following the aforementioned guidelines.

All funding distributed by the Student Association, in the Fall 2022 semester, may be used for either an event open for the entire campus, and/or apparel for group/organization promotional materials. The funds must be used during the Fall 2022 semester and will not carry over to the Spring 2023 semester.
