“The Institutional Legacies of the French Colonial Regime in North America”

This presentation will discuss the preliminary results of three large-scale data analysis projects focused on the descendants of French colonial settlers in the United States. The presentation will address some of the challenges in finding relevant data sources to analyze their political attitudes and socioeconomic development. Three different types of data will be explored: (1) political contributions through public records; (2) partisanship through fifty-six surveys conducted by Harris Polls during the 1960s; and (3) electoral returns through county-level census measures between 1900-2000.
