A near miss is an **incident in which no property was damaged and no personal injury was sustained** but they provide great opportunities to learn and try to prevent future injuries and accidents.

Examples of Near Misses:

- A co-worker trips on material left in the walkway or a dimly lit hallway.
- An employee trips over an extension cord that lies across the floor but avoids a fall by grabbing the corner of a desk.
- An outward-opening door nearly hits a worker who jumps back just in time to avoid a mishap
- A 5-gallon bucket of paint falls from heights, landing close to a worker (without injury or property damage).
