Nothing About Us, Without Us

Dr. Isgro will share a three-year health equity project that she oversaw as the Project Director for the Inclusive Healthcare Partnership Project (IHPP). The Inclusive Healthcare Partnership Project is co-led by the Vermont Developmental Disabilities Council and Green Mountain Self-Advocates, with the goals of improving health literacy among adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) using graphic medicine. Through the use of plain language and graphic medicine, this multi-year project aims to improve the healthcare experience of Vermonters with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities.

People with I/DD are a medically underserved population and often are at higher risk of cancer and other diseases for various reasons. This project illustrates one way health promotion efforts may reach this particular population with the goal of better health outcomes.
